**They have to get applications endorsed by their Principal/Head Master of the respective school**

Submit the filled application at the VITM security entrance (**BEFORE 3<sup>rd</sup> April 2019 for Workshop on Arduino and 10<sup>th</sup> April 2019 for the remaining courses**) with a copy of students ID card of 2018-19.

- On receiving sufficient applications for a course, intimation over phone will be given ( to the contact number given above) for paying the course fee (to be paid at Museum Cash Counter on working days).
  - Course will be conducted only if sufficient students enroll for the course.
  - Registration will be done on first cum first served basis.
  - Seats will be reserved only on payment of fees within the prescribed date.
  - To pay the Course fee, receive the endorsed application already submitted by you from Education Section at 3rd floor.
  - After paying the Course fee (**ONLY IN CASH**), collect the Course I D cards from the Education Officer at Third Floor, without which the seat will not be allotted.
